SUMMARY HIGHLIGHTS:

ScrumBan-Almost never a question of Scrum or Kanban

All knowledge work is continuous knowledge work

Scrum as a “gateway drug” to Kanban

Still may do the ceremonies, but differently:

Standups - Is the work flowing the way we expect?

Retrospectives - something went wrong; how can we prevent in the future

Reviews - review the items

Kanban does not tell you how to do these things -- an asset and a detriment

Start with something as basic as Kanban, and add other things to it

Lexus example: Visualization whereby everything means something (left door open, windshield wiper up, etc.) -- what stage you are in and what you need to look at next
